

# Firefighting for Emergency Response

## Who Should Attend?

Intended for those with little or no, fire fighting experience. Mainly onshore office staff with no formal training. Recommend maximum 15 students. If training facilities exist on site, course content can be advanced to include escape from a smoke filled room, and use of hose lines and nozzles to fight fire. Also familiarity with wearing SCBA and Escape Sets.
